REGULATIONS **on the IDSCA Championship “TOP-100” among Pro-Am couples**

1. OBJECTIVES

- promotion of dance classes among amateurs
- support of the activities of the IDSCA clubs, schools and studios
- strengthening the leading position of the IDSCA in the Pro-Am movement in Russia
- promotion and development of Pro-Am movement in Russia
- increasing the interest of Pro-Am participants in the IDSCA Rating System
- maintaining the status of leader couples of the IDSCA Rating System

2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The IDSCA Championship “**TOP-100**” among Pro-Am couples is held once a year **in the second half of the year** within the framework of the Pro-Am competition, organized by the IDSCA member. The date and the organizer of the Championship shall be approved by the IDSCA Presidium not later than 100 days before the planned date. **Applications for holding from the IDSCA members are accepted until November 30 of the year preceding the Championship.**

The IDSCA Championship “**TOP-100**” among Pro-Am couples is held in the following nominations:

1. International Standard – by age group A
2. International Standard – by age group B
3. International Standard – by age group C+D
4. International Latin – by age group A
5. International Latin – by age group B
6. International Latin – by age group C+D
7. American Smooth – no age groups
8. Argentine Tango Salon – by age group A
9. Argentine Tango Salon – by age group B+C+D
10. Argentine Tango Free Style – by age group A
11. Argentine Tango Free Style – by age group B+C+D
12. Caribbean Mix Cuban Style – no age groups
13. Caribbean Mix Line Style – no age groups

The first **100** participants of the IDSCA Rating System from each age group (Top of All **A**, Top of All **B**, Top of All **C**, Top of All **D**) are admitted to the IDSCA Championship among

Pro-Am couples according to their position in the table on the 1st day of the month preceding the month in which the Championship is held.

Each participant who is in the Top-100 list **for one, two or three age groups** is entitled to register **in one, two or three** of any presented Championship programs, respectively, **in his/her age group or in a group younger**.

Age groups of students in Pro-Am couples:

A – under 35 years old,

B – 36-50 years old,

C – 51-60 years old

D- 61 years old and older.

3. REGULATIONS AND AWARDING OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP PARTICIPANTS

The results of the competition in each program are calculated according to the rules of the Skating System with preliminary rounds (if required) in each age group. No more than 7 couples shall reach the final.

According to the results of the final, the winner – **TOP-100** IDSCA Champion in each nomination – is determined.

Each participant of the final is awarded with a memorable diploma of the finalist of the IDSCA Championship “**TOP-100**” among Pro-Am couples; the prizewinners are awarded with bronze, silver and gold medals, respectively. The winner is awarded with the **TOP-100** IDSCA Championship Cup.

All participants of the IDSCA Championship “**TOP-100**” receive credit points in the IDSCA Rating System in accordance with the Rules with a coefficient of 2 compared to regular competitions.

All Championship finalists are granted a Certificate for a special **10%** discount on registration fees for all competitions held under the auspices of the IDSCA.

The winner in each nomination is awarded a Certificate for 2 entrance tickets to all open calendar competitions held under the auspices of the IDSCA.

Certificates shall take effect after the end of the last block of the IDSCA Championships “TOP-100” of the current year and expire at the end of the last block of the IDSCA Championships “TOP-100” of the next year.

This rule does not apply to registration fees for performances in Showcase and Championship Open (without age categories).

3. PANEL OF JUDGES

The panel of judges is formed from judges who have judicial certification of one of the registered organizations in sport dancing and a presiding judge of the competition. The number of judges must be at least 7 people.



The panel of judges for Caribbean Mix, Argentine Tango must consist of at least 3 people, more than half of the panel of judges shall be experts in these areas.

A Chairperson and members of the panel of judges of the competition shall be approved by the Pro-Am Director of the IDSCA 14 days before the date of the IDSCA Championship “TOP-100” among Pro-Am couples.

4. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

Participation in the IDSCA Championship “TOP-100” is free of charge.

Each participant shall only purchase an entrance ticket.

The organizer is obliged to provide for the availability of entrance tickets, which shall cost no more than 1500 rubles.

The cost of VIP tickets and packages is set by the organizer independently.
